The AIM Educational Opportunity Center (EOC) offers assistance for people looking to pursue postsecondary education.

Several free services are available and are designed to help assist program participants in understanding their educational options, and navigate the college admissions and financial aid process.

With help from a federally funded TRIO grant from the Department of Education, AIM EOC assists over 1,000 people in a 14 county region.
